

University Study in Aviation Management at Massey

Airways and Massey University are working together to encourage high school graduates selected by Airways for Air Traffic Control training to study towards the **Bachelor of Aviation Management** degree.

Note All students must meet Massey University's entry requirements.

The Bachelor of Aviation Management degree programme (BAvMan)

Massey recognises Airways own ATC training program as an integral part of this degree and offers a collaborative program for approved students. Students accepted by Airways for ATC training can study full time towards their degree at Massey for 2 years and then complete their ATC training at Airways in their 3rd year.

On successful completion of the 3rd year, students earn both their Air Traffic Controller's licence and their Bachelor of Aviation Management degree.

The collaborative degree program

The collaborative study option consists of 2 stages:

- ➔ 2 years full time study at Massey
- ➔ 1 year full time ATC training at Airways

Students study 16 papers at Massey over 2 years (fulltime) followed by 1 year fulltime at Airways ATC training.
