▶ Training Management

This course introduces the necessary skills for the effective management of trainees and instructors in accordance with educational best practices in industry training. It will develop participants' skills relevant to leading, supervising or managing training staff and students.

▶ Classroom Instructional Techniques

This course provides participants with the knowledge and techniques necessary to train groups of people in a classroom environment. Instruction will be provided in the skills necessary to be an effective instructor, how to manage the training cycle and the importance of stakeholder feedback and self-review as part of the process.

► Watch Supervisor

The aim of this course is to equip participants with the necessary skills required to function as a Watch or Shift Supervisor. Participants will be introduced to the key concepts of effective leadership and their role in safety. They will also be able to identify strategies in order to support and communicate with their teams.

► Instructor (Theory)

This course provides participants with instructional techniques and tools to manage and motivate a trainee's performance using a competency framework, positive reinforcement and continuous assessment for effective diagnosis of skill deficiencies and application of skill enhancement strategies in a timely manner.

Participants will take away a toolbox of knowledge, skills and aide memories to assist them in any future ATC Instructor role they may undertake.

► Instructor (Theory & Simulator)

Participants in this course will learn the same instructional techniques and tools as described above – learning the theory in the classroom environment, and then practicing these in action in Airways' advanced and highly realistic ATC simulator.

► Safety Analysis and Investigation

Participants in this course will gain an understanding of the air traffic control accident investigation process and will be equipped with the knowledge and skills to participate in and support formal investigations.

► Examiner/Assessor

This course provides participants with the knowledge, skills and assessment techniques to be able to design, moderate, and undertake valid and reliable assessments, for the issue of ATS ratings and validations using a competency framework.

Participants will learn via a combination of interactive lectures, case studies, assessment simulation activities and group activities.

► Human Factors

Participants on this course will be introduced to human factors (performance) terminology in aviation. They will gain an understanding of the factors affecting an individual's performance, and how to apply human factor knowledge using practical tools to improve safety in an operational environment.

The course will be presented via a combination of interactive training, group discussions and relevant case studies.
